Tech Returners is an inclusive accessible and positive learning and coaching community empowering careers into and through technology with a range of programmes, resources and development tools. The organisation is committed to removing the barriers which returners face after a career break and to tackle the skills shortage in technology by empowering people into technology careers and providing continuous support on their journeys through technology and into leadership.

Since 2017 we've enabled more than 29 returners into careers in technology and have grown a community of more than 100 returners as a result of our programme Your Journey Into Tech, there are currently more than 40 returners taking part in our programmes and we're not stopping there; our programmes are growing and so is our team, having already tripled in size since 2018 we're now looking for a Tech Coach to join us and provide technical delivery and support to the returners in our programme.

ABOUT THE ROLE

Our Returner Programme: Your Journey Into Tech

Tech Returners runs training programmes with the purpose of educating and introducing people back (or into) technical roles. We provide free 15 week courses that focus on full-stack development covering a range of front-end development skills, back-end development skills, cloud technologies and supporting technical practices such as agile, test-driven development and pair programming. This is all underpinned by personal development sessions and 1-2-1 coaching.

As a Tech Coach, you will operate in our sessions supporting a Lead Tech Coach on delivery of our "Your Journey into Tech" programmes and review/feedback/support our cohorts with their weekly homework.

Technical Role

Alongside the educational elements of your role, we are also committed to ensuring our technical staff remain technical. As a result of this, you will also be developing internal projects through the entire product development life cycle - from understanding the needs of our users right through to software delivery, deployment and monitoring.

Here you will work within technologies and areas such as:

- Web Technologies (HTML/CSS/React)
- Cloud Technologies (Amazon Web Services / Google Cloud)
- Cross-Platform Mobile App Development
- Software Development Project Management Tools

The project is a greenfield project and will allow for our Tech Coach to experience the full stack development cycle.

Working in a fast-paced environment with a focus on providing a positive learning experience for all of our returners, you'll have a passion for learning and for that sharing that learning with others, whilst remaining flexible in your approach when delivering outcomes and having clarity of communication.

You'll have a growth mindset with the ability to look at solutions through different angles through systems thinking, and you'll be commercially astute with a willingness to seek and spot opportunities to further develop the brand and Tech Returners community,


